- 3) Brief presentation on the status of GMA 9 activities, DFCs, GAM Runs, and other items of interest.
- 4) Receive Public Input on the following DRAFT DFC ALTERNATIVES offered by GMA 9 for public consideration:
  - (a) **Edwards Group of the Edwards-Trinity Plateau**
    - (1) No net increase in average drawdown through 2060
    - (2) Allow no more than a 9 feet increase in average drawdown by 2060
    - (3) Declare the Edwards Group to be a "not relevant" aquifer for all or part of GMA 9
  - (b) **Trinity Aquifer** (*includes: the Upper Trinity (Upper Glen Rose Limestone), the Middle Trinity (Lower Glen Rose Limestone, Hensel Sand, and Cow Creek Limestone), and the Lower Trinity (Hosston, Sligo, and Sycamore Sands)*)
    - (1) Allow no more than a 20 foot increase in average drawdown by 2060
    - (2) Allow no more than a 30 foot increase in average drawdown by 2060
    - (3) Allow no more than a 40 foot increase in average drawdown by 2060
- 5) Briefing on proposed GMA 9 timeline for setting DFCs.
- 6) Adjournment.
